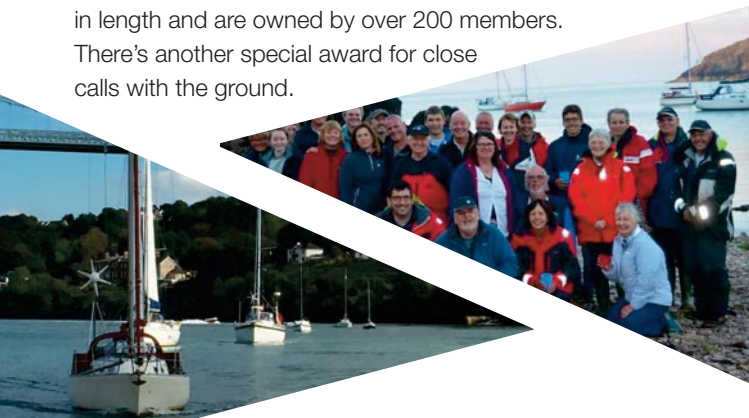




How to join the Venturers?
